
Opportunistic CT (On Demand) Hide

This session will briefly review evidence supporting opportunistic use of existing abdominal and chest CT scans to evaluate patients bone status. How to perform this clinically will be demonstrated and practical considerations of potential confounders of this approach will be discussed. Additionally, the potential for opportunistic CT to evaluate sarcopenia will be considered.




- Once the survey is completed, you will have a pop-up thanking you for completing it, and then you will be automatically brought to the screen to claim your Credits. Choose the Credit type you would like, and then click the **SUBMIT** button.

Note: If you click **SUBMIT** without selecting the credit type from the drop down, the credit type default is AMA PRA Category 1 Credit (**Non-Physician**).

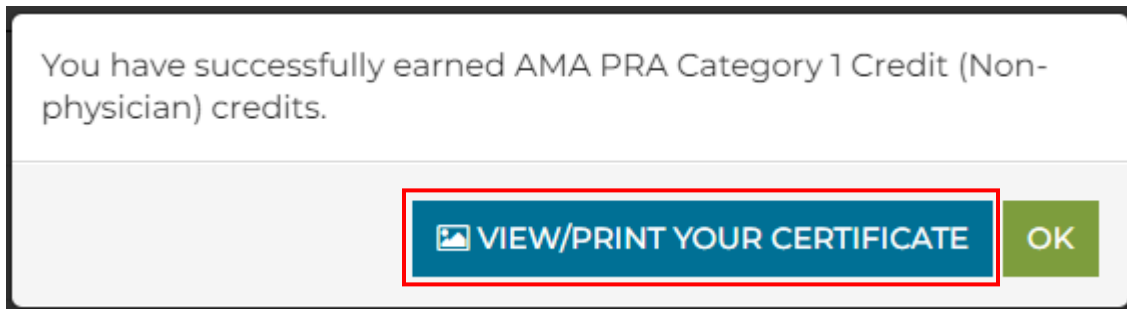
Note: The amount of credits defaults to the maximum possible, but participants claiming ACCME credits (both types of AMA PRA Category 1 Credit) should only claim credit for the amount of time they engaged with the activity, to the closest .25 hour (i.e. 1 Hour would be 1 credit, 30 minutes would be .5 credits, etc.) ASRT requires participants to complete the entire activity to claim credit, so anyone claiming Category A CE Credit should choose the maximum.



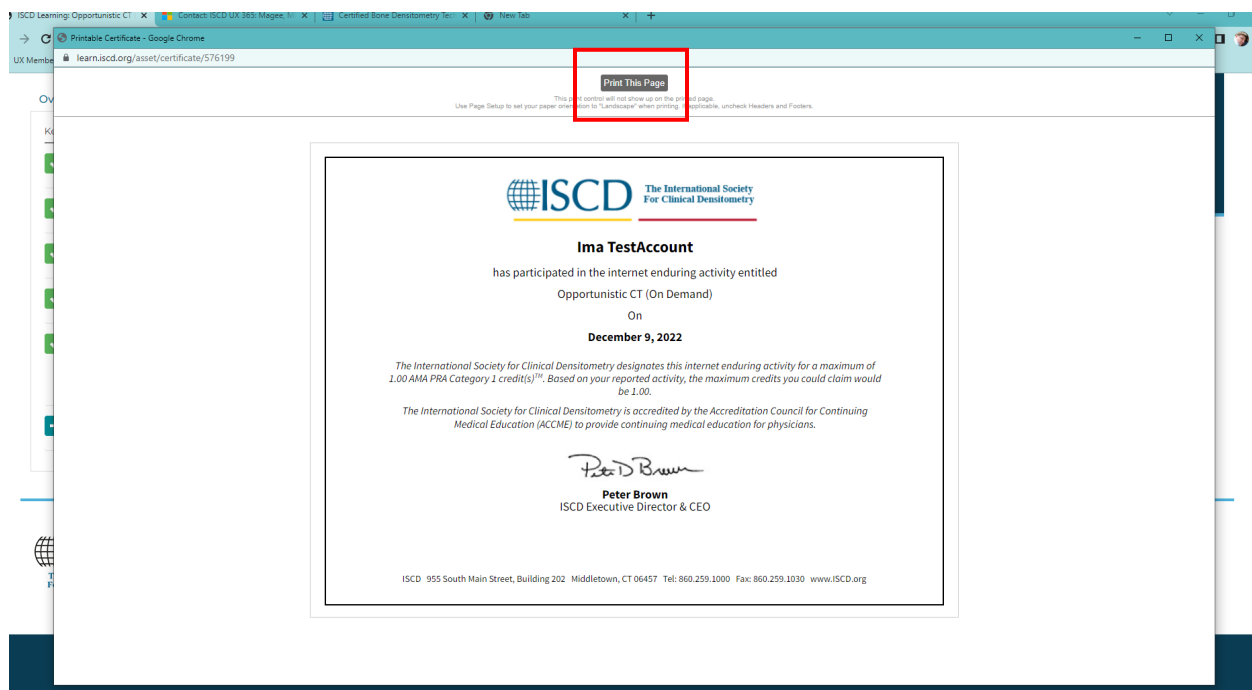

- Once you submitted your Credit Choice, you will again automatically receive a pop-up stating you can now view/print your Certificate of Completion.


Note: Make sure to click **“View/Print Your Certificate.”** Clicking **“OK”** instead will take you back to the Dashboard without viewing your Certificate.



- You will now get a new pop-up displaying a digital copy of your your Certificate of Completion. If you click the **“Print this Page”** button, it will begin the process to print your certificate (or save it to your computer in digital format, if you prefer). This will be different depending on the specific machine you are using.



- You can return to the activity as long as it is up, open the Continuing Education Certificate task and print the certificate again.

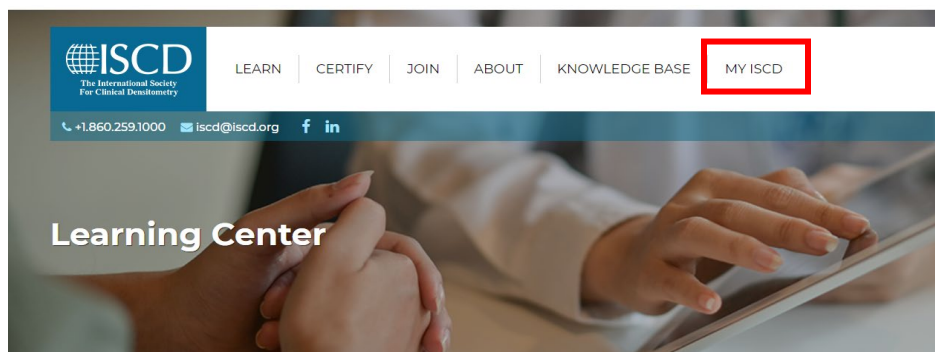




